

## Truchard Vineyard Merlot



Heralding from the famous Truchard vineyard in Carneros (Napa side), this old vine head trained Merlot reaches levels of concentration not normally found from this region. A supple ruby core gives way to a developed rim. This Merlot pronounces itself with flamboyant aromas of blueberry, blackcurrant and vanilla. Its presence on the palate awakes the jaded taste buds as crisp tannins surround a luxurious fruit core. True to its varietal, there is not any astringency to be found on the finish which travels effortlessly over the palate carrying chocolate covered cherry notes and a slight white pepper component into a mile long finish.



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
