Coming from a tiny terraced section of red, volcanic soils next to Peter Michael's vineyard in the northern part of the valley, the 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon Weitz Vineyard is another exotic, beautifully complex wine from this estate. Full-bodied, seamless, elegant, and incredibly long, it has an undeniable minerality as well as awesome notes of black cherries, blueberries, graphite, iodine, chocolate, and dusty earth. It's beautiful stuff and has a pretty, deceptively elegant style that hides considerable underlying grip, structure, and minerality.
